


All: O Israel, hope in the LORD! For with the LORD there is steadfast love, and with him is plentiful redemption. And he will redeem Israel from all his iniquities.





And should not you have had mercy on your fellow servant, as I had mercy on you?'


## Matthew 18:34 ESV

And in anger his master delivered him to the jailers, until he should pay all his debt.


#### Matthew 18:35 ESV
