














Mark 1:1-8

⁷ And he preached, saying, "After me comes he who is mightier than I, the strap of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie.









"Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace,


according to your word;

a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel."







¹⁵ (John bore witness about him, and cried out, "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me.")






