W.L.: He has caused his wondrous works to be remembered; the LORD is gracious and merciful. He sent redemption to his people; he has commanded his covenant forever.


All: Holy and awesome is his name! The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practice it have a good understanding. His praise endures forever!

For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror.




For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like.











