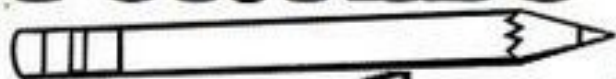
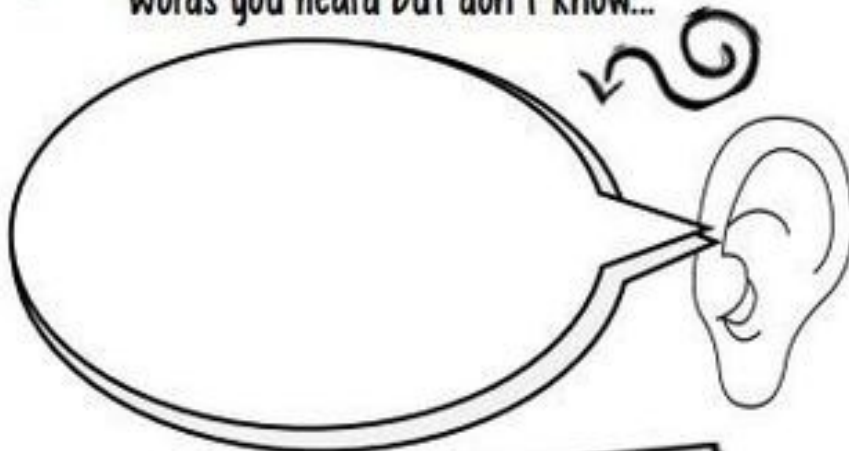

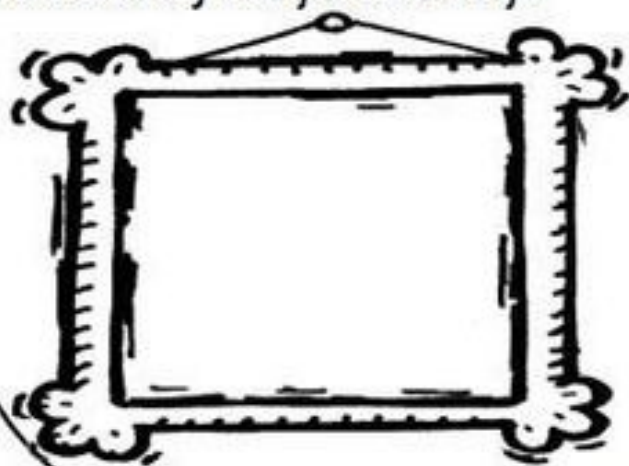

Things to pray about:

In our scripture today, some Jews from Thessalonica followed Paul to Berea and caused trouble, so Paul left and went to the city of Athens in Greece. Paul was upset by what he saw in Athens. The people there did not worship the one true God. Instead, they worshiped many idols. Paul talked with the people who lived in Athens and told them the good news about Jesus and the resurrection. The men asked Paul to explain what he was talking about. So Paul went to a meeting with them and said, "Men of Athens, I can see that you are very religious. I saw in your city an altar that said: 'TO AN UNKNOWN GOD.' You worship a god that you do not know. This is the God I want to tell you about." So Paul told the people about the one true God. He explained that God made everything, and that He is bigger than man-made temples. God is not like the idols in Athens. He is not made of gold, silver, or stone. Paul said that God wants everyone in the world to turn away from their sin and turn to Him. When the people heard about Jesus being raised from the dead, some of them laughed. Some of them wanted to hear more later. Some of them joined Paul and became believers. Some of those believers went with Paul when he left Athens.
