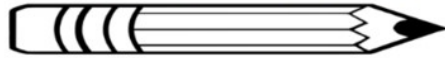

We're back in Acts this week. In Chapter 24, Paul had just spent TWO YEARS in jail, even though he'd done nothing wrong. The Jewish leaders just didn't like it that he was telling people about Jesus. In Acts Chapter 25, the new official named Festus took over and Paul appeared before him in court. Paul said he'd done nothing wrong, and wanted to appear before the King, so Festus agreed, because he thought Paul would be found guilty.
