Lots of times in the New Testament, Jesus talks about himself being the vine, and we are the branches, and that if we trust in Him we bear good fruit. In the Old Testament, in Isaiah 5, the Lord compares His people to a vineyard, where grapes are grown. Instead of the vineyard being full of good, sweet grapes, it was full of wild grapes, which are sour—not good fruit. God said this to tell the people that they had turned away from Him. God has to punish sin, so He has no choice but to destroy the vineyard. God sent this message through Isaiah to warn the people.
