## Communicants Class (Formerly Confirmation Class)

The Westkirk Communicants Class is a 12-week journey through 17 lessons through the Bible on *Understanding the Faith*. Pastor Michael and Pastor Styles will utilize the Westminster Shorter Catechism



to help our students gain a firm grounding in Christianity so that those who have not yet made profession of faith or been admitted into Communicant (full) Membership in the church will not only understand what the meaning of membership is, but who our Triune God is, who we are, and our need of salvation and the Church.
