New Concerns:

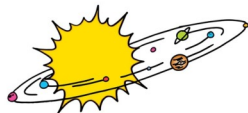
- **Rebecca Donaldson**, working out the final details for her move to Greece. Pray that God would facilitate communication with the Greek Consulate.

Astronauts of **all ages** will join our Space Crews as we orbit through Space Stations to discover one of the five solas of faith each week!

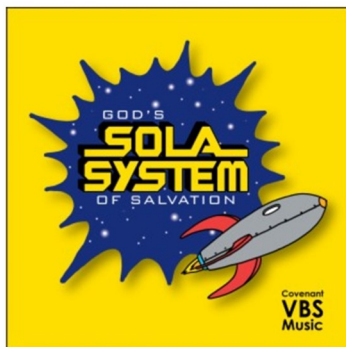
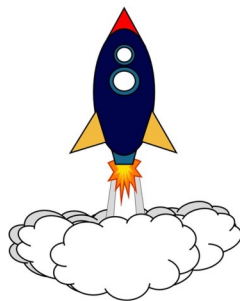
Sola Scriptura - Through Scripture Alone
