- **Judy Gaumer**, having an MRI on Monday, June 14, with a follow-up appointment on June 15.

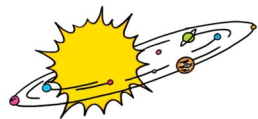
### Continue to pray for:

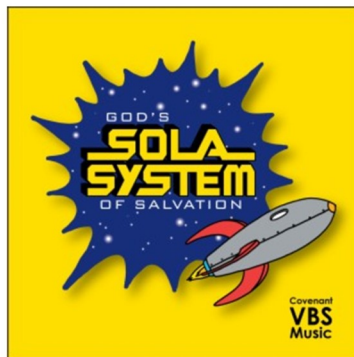
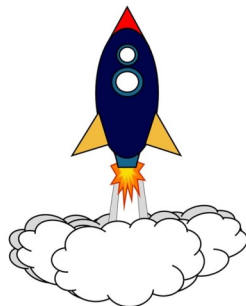
Astronauts of **all ages** will join our Space Crews as we orbit through Space Stations to discover one of the five solas of faith each week!
