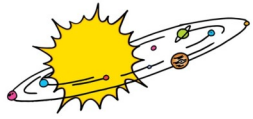
- Caroline, three year old granddaughter of Kirk and Mona Yentes, suffered a leg injury on a trampoline.

Astronauts of **all ages** will join our Space Crews as we orbit through Space Stations to discover one of the five solas of faith each week!

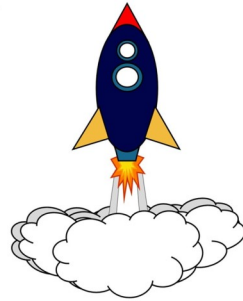
Sola Scriptura - Through Scripture Alone
