Missions Trip to Greece - October 9-17, 2021

Pastor Nathan and Jess Hiatt will be leading this fall's missions trip to Athens. The dates have been set for October 9 to 17, and the estimated cost is \$2500 with support coming from the Westkirk Evangelism Committee as well as through fund raising. The women on the trip will serve at Community House Damaris, the ministry we support that is a home for survivors of human trafficking. The men will work with one of the other area ministries that our missionaries, Argyris and Dina Petrou and their family, are engaged with in the Athens area. Do not let cost dissuade you from considering this opportunity to serve, but it is time (the end of July) to finalize the composition of the team!
