Sponsor Goal: \$100 per volunteer

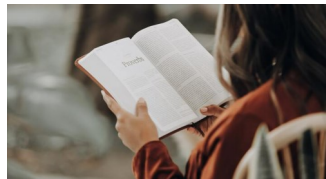
